### The Crow and the Fox

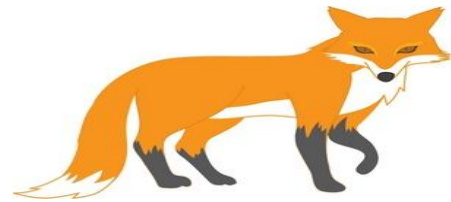

## Science

### Living and Non Living Things

We observe different things and events around us. All those things and events make our environment. All things can be classified into two groups; living things and non-living things. Those who have life are called living things. Living things grow and produce other living things. Such as- people, animal, plants. Living things need food, habitat, shelter, water and air to survive. All living things need habitats. A habitat is a special place where plants grow and animals live in. Animals need shelter. A shelter is a place where animals can be safe. Shelter provides animals with protection from adverse weather conditions such as rainfall and storm. Non-living things do not eat, drink and grow. They cannot produce other things. All non-living things can be divided into two groups. They are (1) man-made non-living things; such as - building, road, chair, table, etc. (2) nature made non-living things; such as- water, soil, air, etc.

## Plants and Animals

There are two kinds of living things. They are plants and animals. A plant has roots, stems, branches and leaves. Plants cannot move from one place to another. Plants can make their own food. A plant needs sunlight, water and carbon-di-oxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) from air to produce food. And it emits oxygen (O<sub>2</sub>) when producing food. Plant can't take all types of food (Such as - Solid). Most animals have the ability to move freely. Animals cannot make their own food. They eat plants and other animals. Animals take oxygen from air and emit carbon-di-oxide. Animal can take all types of food. Actually plants and animals are related to each other. And all living things depend on each other.
